STRENGTHEN YOUR PASSWORDS

- Use a password manager

ENABLE TWO-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION



- A 2nd layer of identity verification (SMS code, biometrics, registered device)

REGULARLY MONITOR YOUR ACCOUNTS



- Set up notifications for transactions
- Regularly review account statements
- Report suspicious activities

BE WARY OF PHISHING SCAMS



- Be cautious with unsolicited emails, messages, or calls that ask for personal information

KEEP YOUR SOFTWARE UPDATED



- Enable automatic updates on your devices for the latest security patches.

USE SECURE NETWORKS



- Avoid public WI-Fi
- Use private connections or VPN
