Stay Alert for Phishing Scams

Use Strong, Unique Passwords

- Create a complex mix: uppercase/lowercase letters, numbers, and symbols.
- Avoid easy guesses like birthdates or simple sequences.
- Use a reliable password manager to secure them.

Monitor Your Accounts Regularly

- Review statements frequently to detect suspicious activity early.
- Regularly check physical or digital bank statements.
- Quickly spot and report discrepancies in your transactions.

Be Cautious with Public Wi-Fi

- Unsecured public networks are prime targets for hackers.
- Avoid logging into online banking while on public networks.
- Use a Virtual Private Network (VPN) if you must connect.

Educate Yourself and Your Community

- Learn common scams, modern fraud tactics, and warning signs.
- Share your knowledge with family, friends, and neighbors.
- Attend financial literacy workshops and stay informed.
